public places/services), Housing and Commercial Property.  
PA law, in general, prohibits discrimination based on race,  
color, age (40 and over), sex, ancestry, national origin,  
religion, familial status (only in housing), disability and the  
use, handling or training of guide or support animals for  
disability.
